



1. INTRODUCTION

Molescroft Primary School is committed to supporting Fair Trade wherever possible and seeks to maintain Fair Trade Status. This is achieved through the following:

2. PLANNING FOR DEVELOPMENT

- Fair Trade is part of the Molescroft Eco Schools Development Plan and therefore feeds into the School Improvement Plan.

3. USE OF FAIR TRADE PRODUCTS

- The Staff have agreed to purchase only Fair Trade tea, coffee and sugar for refreshments provided to guests and used by staff through the in-house refreshments scheme.
- When cooking in Design and Technology we agree to use wherever possible Fair Trade ingredients.
- The Friends of Molescroft Primary School have agreed to only sell/supply tea, coffee and sugar which are Fair Trade at all their events.
- We seek to influence the LA to include the use of Fair Trade products. We also seek to influence our fresh fruit supplier to source Fair Trade fruit.
- We are encouraging our school uniform supplier to make items from Fairtrade cotton

4. CURRICULUM

- Fair Trade is taught as part of appropriate subjects. This occurs as a minimum every year in:
 - Years 3&4 through a PSHCE Unit of work
 - Year 5 through an Enterprise Day unit of work
 - All years through discussions in the Really Wild Club sessions



5. PROMOTING FAIR TRADE IN THE COMMUNITY

- We promote Fair Trade within the school community.
 - This includes a special assembly every year.
 - The school Green Team sell Fair Trade products through a shop “Crofty’s Fairtrading Post” open every Friday at 2:15pm.
 - The local Fairtrade representative is invited to set up a Fair Trade stall at the Annual International Evening and also the Annual Exhibition of Work evening.
